



## **Yaaaay We Are Re-opening on Monday!**

We are pleased to confirm that following the Welsh firebreak lockdown announcement from Monday 9th November the Club will re-open with all of the facilities (except the bowling green which has now closed for the winter) and generally the rules will be the same as immediately prior to the Firebreak lockdown with the following limited changes;

### **General**

All members who live outside Bridgend County boundary can now travel to the Club.

### **Tennis**

- To address the large demand for Courts in peak times (weekends and from 4pm weekdays) it will no longer be possible for one person to book a Court for longer than an hour until the Clay courts are open and provide more Court capacity.**

We anticipate that the Clay courts will be open in around 2 weeks time.

Please note that we can't prevent people from booking more than an hour but if they do, the second hour will be cancelled off the system.

Tennis court booking on the ClubSpark will reopen tomorrow morning at 08:00 so please get booking then (the restrictions on the number of bookings will be as before).

Please note that due to a glitch in the Booking system members were able to book courts so to be fair to all members all of these bookings will be cancelled tonight. Like that everyone will have an equal opportunity to book the Courts.

Coaching will resume as before.

### **Squash**

Rules as before the Firebreak but note the following

- Matches are now only permitted from players in the same household or players from their extended household.**

**Players not from the same household or extended household can only play social distance squash/routines or solo practice.**

## Clubhouse

- The Toilets and Showers will reopen with the same rules as before.
- The Bar and Outside seating areas will reopen on Monday at 5pm using our interpretation of the latest WG guidelines for Bars - further details of which will be issued over the weekend

Thanks everyone for your patience and enjoy getting back on Court. Face covering and social distancing is still mandatory.
