Bridgend Association of Tennis, Bowls and Squash Clubs CIC -Policy for Allocation of Parking Fobs-

The CIC Board have agreed that allocation of Parking Fobs will be based on the following criteria. Note that Policy relates to the period when the Barrier is down. [i.e. Monday to Friday, 4pm to 10am the following morning.] As instructed by BCBC Planning Conditions the Barrier will remain down during the weekend.

All Members can apply. There will be an application form. This will need to be completed by the 18th of August and handed in at the Bar.

Priority of allocation will be as follows:

- 1. Volunteer workforce. This is based on a weekly commitment of at least 6hrs per week
- 2. The Executive Officers [i.e. Directors who are engaged in the regular day to day running of the Club]
- 3. The Disabled Users
 - a. Disabled people who are regular users of the facilities
 - b. Disabled people who are occasional users, can gain access through prior arrangements with the Manager
- 4. Other Regular users such The Brewery Service Deliveries and Contractors will gain access through direct arrangements with the Manager/Staff/Executive Officers
- 5. Club Staff, Director of Coaching, Senior Coach.
- 6. Above 75yrs people with limited mobility and other health issues (subject to usage of the Club)

All potential applicants including the priority groups listed above, **must submit an application form**. Where arbitration is deemed necessary the applications will be considered by an independent 'Fob group'.

There will be an initial returnable deposit of £10 per Fob allocation. Fobs are renewable every year (12 months). Once the membership has expired the fob will also expire. If the fob is lost there will be an additional charge of £20 for replacement. Fobs are not transferable between users of the Club.

Parking Policy will be under regular review. 30 fobs are available for allocation.
